charge. The employees' wages and salaries are guaranteed for a period of three months thanks to specific substitute benefits provided under German insolvency law. The PLUTA team is in the process of securing pre-financing of these. This will ensure that the salaries are paid as normal.

The company has filed for insolvency due to liquidity problems resulting from declining sales. Management said, "Our motivated team is working with the provisional insolvency administrator on a long-term solution. We hope to secure an investor."
